With this kind of support, you'll develop that rare confidence that comes from feeling deeply understood, and a true value and appreciation for yourself and others.



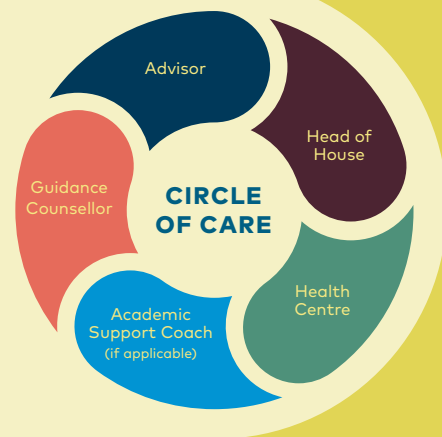

The TCS journey is more rewarding than you can imagine, and more affordable than you might think. We award \$3.5 million in need-based bursaries and another \$500,000 in merit-based scholarships every year.
