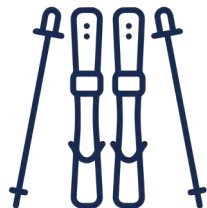

# EXPLORE WHAT'S POSSIBLE

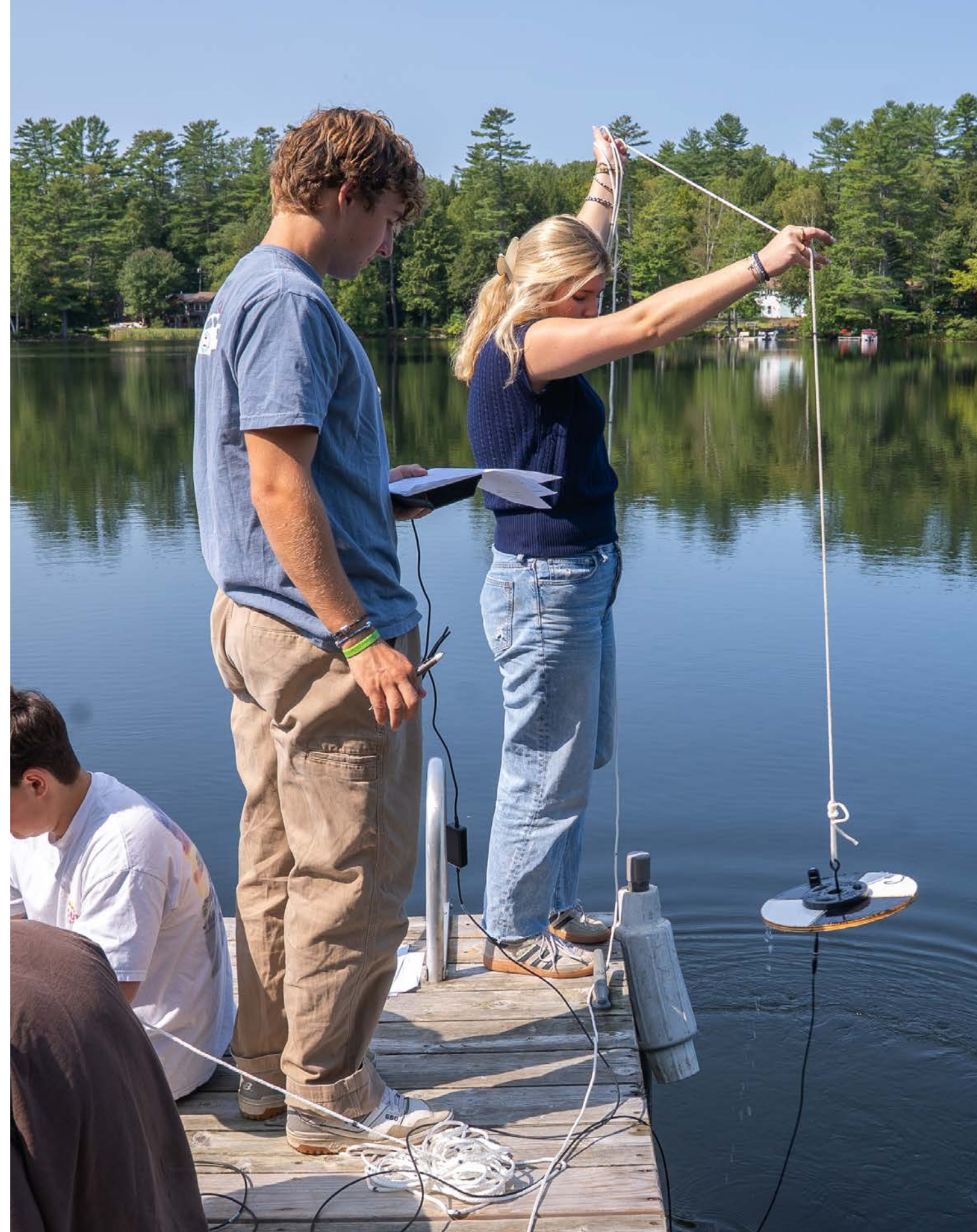

Just steps from dorms and classrooms, the Alpine Training Center is a private slope for skiing and snowboarding with state-of-the-art grooming and snowmaking.





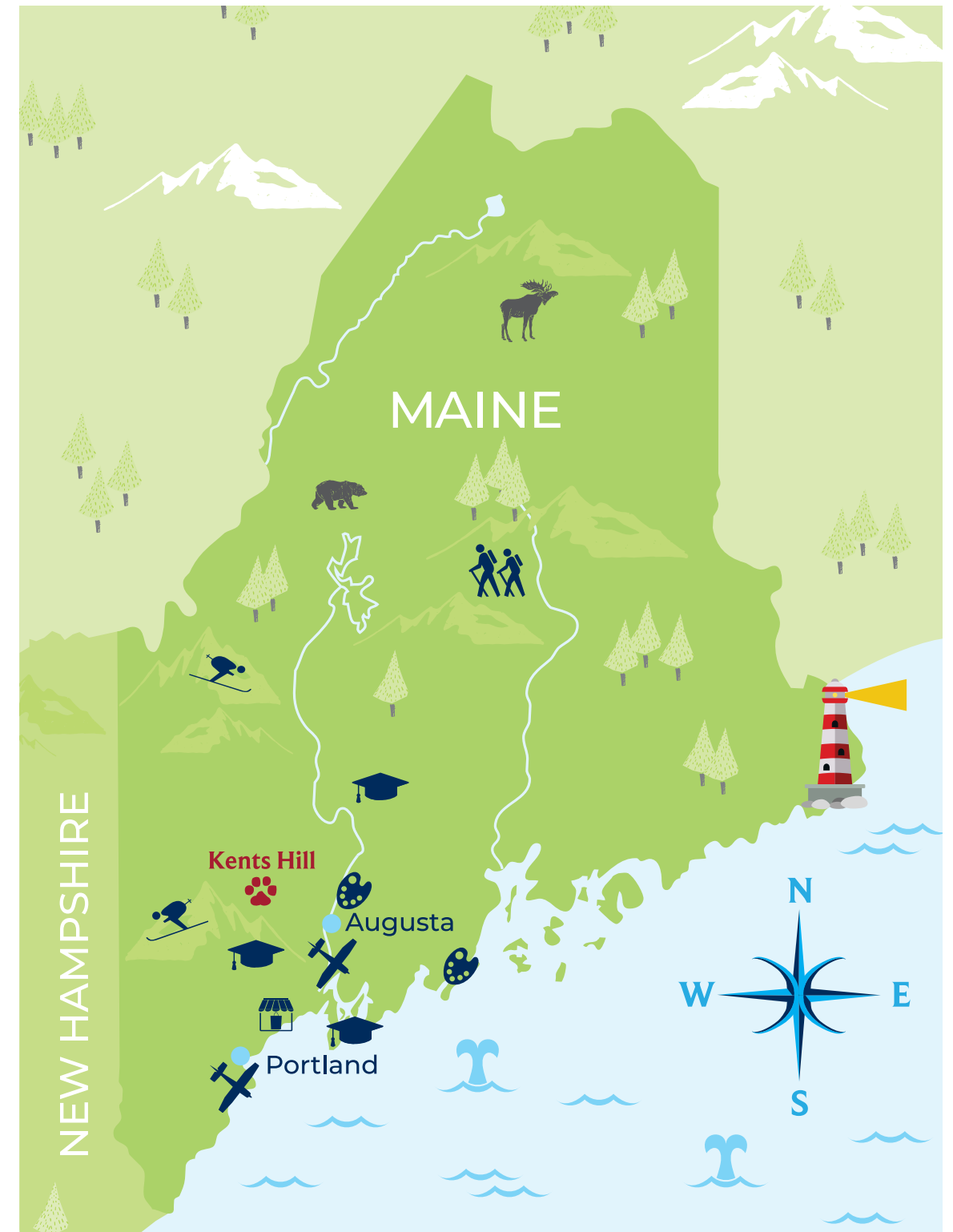
# GROUND ED IN MAINE, CONNECTED TO THE WORLD
