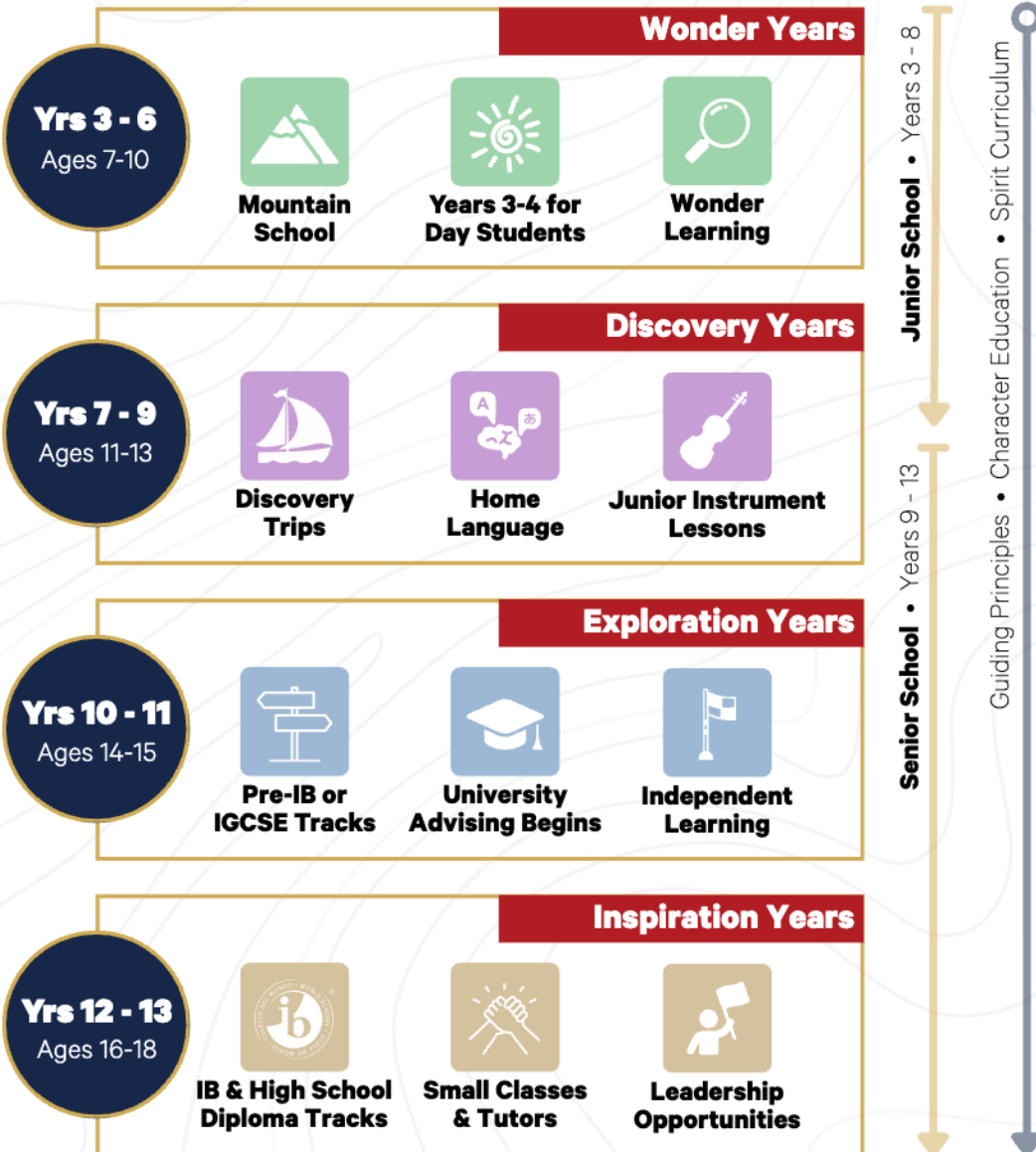

Inspiring Creativity

In October 2024, Aiglon became the first (and so far, only) Swiss school to be named an **All-Steinway Institution**, using Steinway & Sons pianos for all aspects of its music programme. The 88 Keys campaign, enabling donors to contribute by gifting keys, has secured for Aiglon a Steinway Model D grand piano – the instrument overwhelmingly chosen by the world's greatest pianists.
