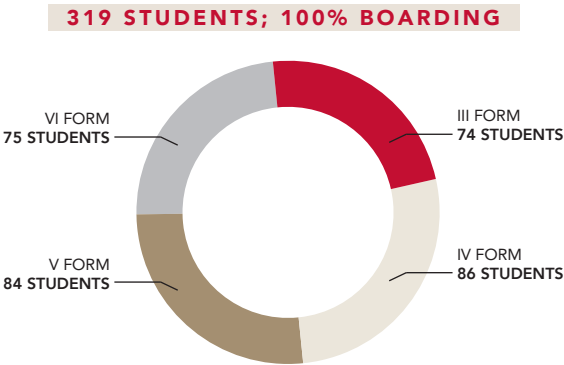
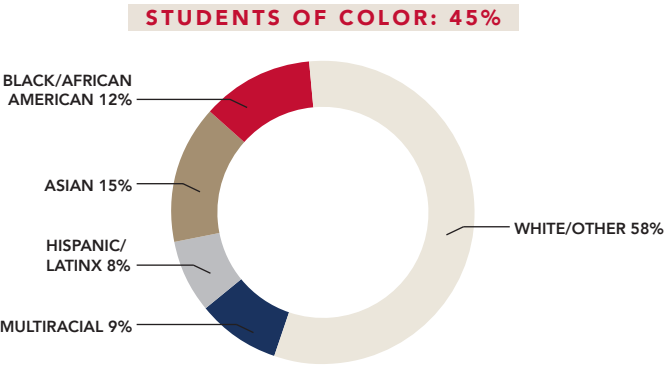
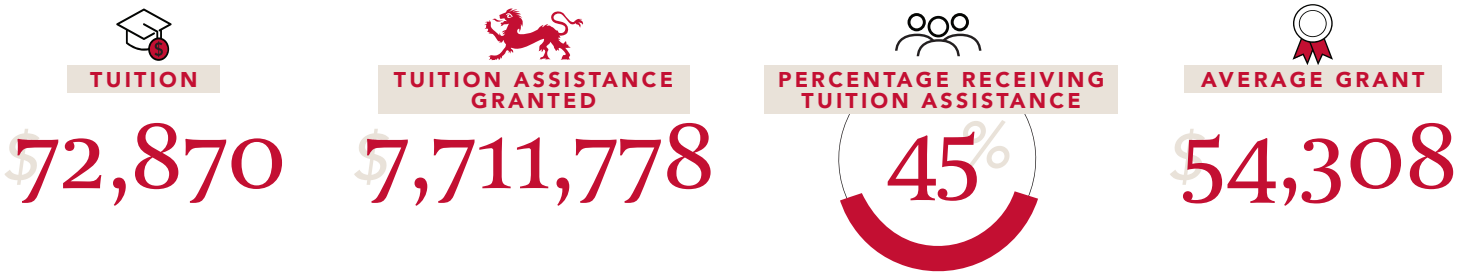


ST. ANDREW'S SCHOOL

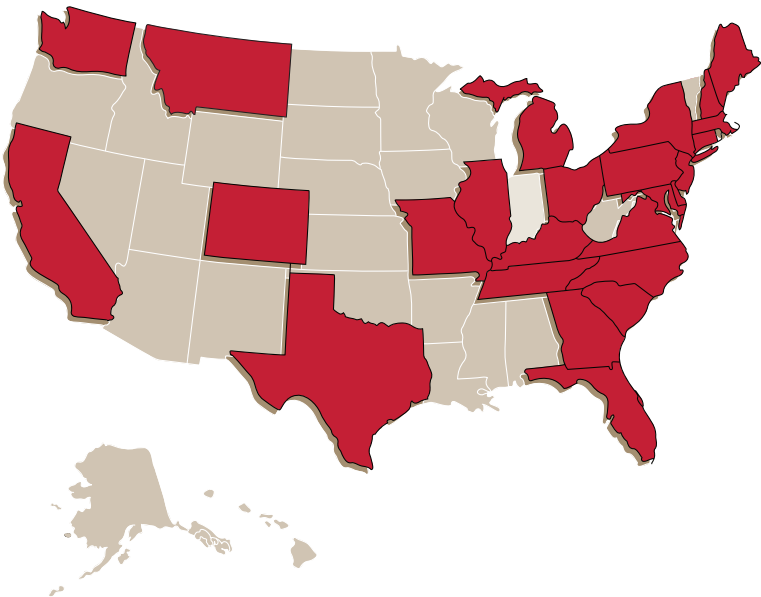

In addition to the rigor of our standard classes, students may enroll in honors, Advanced Study courses, and Advanced Topic Tutorials. Advanced Study (AS) designates that a course is offered at the collegiate level. Advanced Topic Tutorial (ATT) designates that a course is offered at the advanced collegiate level.

ATHLETICS

St. Andrew's encourages students to become multisport athletes, rather than focus intensively on one sport year-round. Our athletic program offers highly personalized coaching and an athletic culture that is at once challenging, competitive, and supportive. St. Andrew's graduates annually go on to compete in NCAA Division I and Division III, and have won NCAA National Championships, played professionally, competed in the Olympics, and won Olympic gold medals.

ARTS

Our visual and performing arts courses and programs are centered on a master-apprentice model in which students learn from and work alongside professional artists. Every student takes part in some aspect of our arts program, and students regularly create and perform works for our community throughout the school year.

COMMUNITY SERVICE

Service is at the heart of the school's commitment to develop habits of community engagement in our students. We do not have a community service requirement. We want students to focus on lives changed, and not hours earned. *More than 70% of students participate weekly in service.*

STUDENT LEADERSHIP

Students hold an enormous amount of responsibility for building and sustaining the culture and community at St. Andrew's: they serve in more than 100 leadership positions in all aspects of campus life and steward our cell phone policy, Honor Code, and no-drug, no-alcohol policy. There are no senior dorms at St. Andrew's. Instead, seniors live throughout the dorms with underformers and are responsible, in partnership with faculty, for management of dorm life.

ENVIRONMENTAL RESPONSIBILITY

We are committed to living in harmony with and caring for our 2,200-acre campus. Students lead sustainability initiatives and work with faculty and staff to steward our land, water, and wildlife, and to contribute to environmental initiatives in the wider world.

St. Andrew's is located in Middletown, Delaware on 2,200 acres on the shores of Noxontown Pond and at the center of a working farm. In addition to the natural resources of our campus, our location offers students access to intellectual and cultural experiences throughout the Mid-Atlantic.

At St. Andrew's, the college application process is a time of deep personal growth and discovery. Our College Counseling team gives each student intensive, highly personalized, private guidance in order to find the best possible match for their college experience.
