DUAL ENROLLMENT

COLLEGE COUNSELING

1 ANNE E. BROSSMAN SWEIGART SPORTS & FITNESS CENTER

Our standard-sized gymnasium is home to the Lady Lions volleyball and basketball teams. The second floor features a dance studio and fitness center.

2 EQUESTRIAN CENTER

Riding facilities include a competition-level 80' x 200' indoor riding ring with a grand viewing deck and comfortable lounge, a large outdoor ring with all-weather footing, and a spacious 20-stall center aisle stable with heated tack room.

This building includes both our dorm lobby and Lombardo Dining Hall, overlooking Campus Drive in the north and the Alumnae Rock Garden towards the south.

MARY DIXON CHAPEL

One of downtown Lititz's most iconic buildings, the chapel was constructed 1883–85 with funds made available by Mr. George W. Dixon of Bethlehem, PA, and dedicated to the memory of his daughter, Mary Dixon.

Our riding program establishes a strong foundation in riding and horsemanship, focusing on hunters, jumpers, dressage, and equitation.



AVIATION

This program provides students with flight lessons in a Cessna aircraft, leading to the attainment of a private pilot's license.

Music, theater, and the visual arts develop students' appreciation for the beauty of human expression.



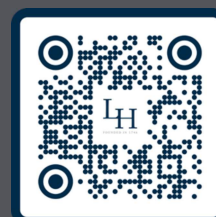
STEM
