Mill Hill School (London, UK)
Mill Hill School educates boys and girls aged 13 to 18 and offers day places alongside weekly and full boarding. Founded in 1807, Mill Hill is the oldest and largest school in the group, and one of the UK's leading HMC schools.



Mill Hill International (London, UK)
Offering a broad range of academic programmes for Boarding and Day pupils aged between 13 and 18, lasting from one term to five years. Benefiting from its own bespoke part of the campus but with access to over 120 acres of Mill Hill Schools' beautiful grounds, just 10 miles from central London.



Mill Hill Short Courses (London, UK)
Spring and Summer Courses for international boys and girls aged 12- 17 years old. Courses combine learning English as a foreign language with either Science and Mathematics or Sport. These core elements are complemented by a varied programme of Creative Arts Classes, two full-day excursions, and a full evening entertainment programme.



Cobham Hall (Kent, UK)

Whilst focusing on academic development, we make sure that each pupil can exploit their talents so that their stay is both enriching and rewarding.
